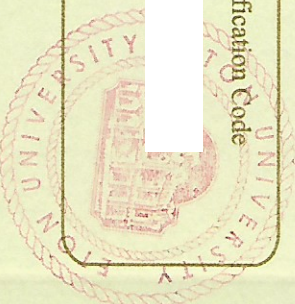

We then moved our operational office to Manchester in the United Kingdom and on April 22nd, 2013, Eton University was incorporated in the State of Delaware, USA. OTHM is another British awarding organization Eton University have partnered with (Centre ID DC1906338) to deliver top-shelf qualifications.

TRANSFER CREDIT

Eton University grants academic credit and advanced standing towards its degrees of appropriate courses satisfactory completed at other recognized institutions. A minimum grade of 2.0 is required in transfer courses applied to the General Education Requirements. A minimum grade of 3.0 is required for all transfer work at the graduate level.

SCHOLASTIC STATUS

Scholastic status may be one of the following:

Good Standing

Academic Probation – A student in this status is below good standing scholastic standards of the university but is allowed to continue in attendance

Academic Suspension – A student in this status may be re-admitted only with the approval of the dean of the academic unit involved.

GRADING SYSTEM

Eton University instituted a decimal grading system in graduate classes in lieu of alphabetical grading. At the graduate level, 1.6 is the minimum grade for which credit is earned. The university adopted a formula for equating decimal grades to percentages; this is shown in the following table.
